85% Of the shares are owned by the government of Curaçao while 15% are owned by a local development bank. Curinde was incorporated in 1980.

Curinde's Mission

To attract, assist and stimulate trading and production companies to reach their objectives and consequently contribute to sustainable economic and social growth of Curaçao.

Core business

As the operator and managing company of two Free (Economic) Zones and one Industrial Park in Curaçao, we offer fully serviced business parks. Curinde provides professional support to companies interested to establish in one of its afore-mentioned business parks.

For companies interested in starting or expanding exports, Curaçao with its strategic location offers interesting possibilities through its Free (Economic) Zones and supporting business services.

Curinde promotes and facilitates businesses in the export trading industry interested to use Curaçao as a point of distribution of their products to the Caribbean, North and South America, and Europe.

A Free (Economic) Zone is a fenced-in Customs area where merchandise may be stored, displayed, produced or processed and where selected services are permitted free from import duties or government excise taxes.

The government of Curaçao offers attractive incentives to companies established in the Curaçao Free (Economic) Zones:

- 0% Import duties
- 0% Turnover tax
- 2% profit tax on export profits
- 0% land and property tax

General information

In addition to these attractive incentives, Curinde offers fully developed business parks with flexible multi-purpose buildings that are readily available for those who wish to start immediately.

Furthermore, it is worth mentioning that brand protection is very high on the list. Curinde has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the International Anti-Counterfeiting Coalition (IACC) in order to provide Free (Economic) Zones where intellectual property agreements and laws are strictly enforced. Through a multidisciplinary approach, consisting of the Government of Curaçao, Customs, the Public Prosecutor and Curinde, with the cooperation of IACC, Curaçao is working consistently to respect and protect intellectual property while offering brands a safe haven to conduct business in its Free (Economic) Zones.
